In collaboration with the CEO, the Community Relations Specialist (CRS), and the leadership team, the DDC develops and executes plans that elevate Origami's presence in the rehabilitation and non-profit communities on a local and statewide level. The DDC is responsible for the planning, organizing and directing of all fundraising including major gifts, annual and multi-year giving, special events, endowments and other campaigns. The DDC works closely with the CEO in all development and fundraising efforts.
