<b>Program</b> Hours of operation	<b>Residential Program</b> Program provides services 24 hours per day, 7 days per week in homelike environment. Lengths of stay can vary from respite, transitional, and long term.		<b>Community Based Program</b> Program provides daily services and supports based on the individual needs. Lengths of stay can vary from respite, transitional, and long term.		<b>Outpatient Program</b> Monday-Friday 8am-5pm (day and hours of service may vary based on individual needs).

<b>Diagnosis and Medical Status</b>	Primary diagnosis of brain injury; however, may provide services to individuals with other neurological disorders as long as the established admission criteria is met.
